

Transport related projects in Russia

Since 1997, Transportutvikling AS has been working with projects where the main focuses have been on logistics- and transport opportunities in North-West Russia and Russia in general.

During the last 20 years Transportutvikling AS has developed extensive experience and competence when it comes to the Russian market and Russian transport solutions, particularly related to:

- Railway transports
- Multi modal transit operations through Russia
- Sea transports
- Ports and port development



60 projects where Russia is involved

As per October 2016 we have conducted close to 60 projects involving Russian market players and the Russian market. The majority of the projects concerns transport solutions and market evaluations.

Together with the Russian Railways (RZD) and the International Union of Railways (UIC), we have been planning and assessing transport corridors between Europe and Asia, and intermodal operations crossing the Caspian Sea.

A few examples (2008-2016):

- 2008: Acted as project manager for the development of «The North South Corridor», which is an intermodal transport solution between Moscow and India, Azerbaijan and Iran. Clients: Russian railways and Iranian authorities
- 2009: Conducted an extensive market analysis focusing on the Russian coal market and transport opportunities from Russia to major power plants in Europe. Client: Australian Coal Company
- 2010: Completed the project "Railway corridor in the north" where existing and potential corridors to Russia were focused on. Client: Norwegian Governmental Authorities
- 2011: Analyzed commercial and logistical opportunities for import of biomass from Russia to Norway. Clients: Norwegian shipping lines, Russian exporters and the Barents Secretariat.
- 2012: Completed the pre-study «Ishavsbanen», a potential railway connection between Norway and Finland, and connections to this railway. Client: Regional authorities in Norway, Sweden and Finland.
- 2013: Produced a pre-study and arranged B2B meetings between 8 Norwegian maritime companies and Russian clients. Clients: The companies, the Arctic Maritime Cluster and Innovation Norway.
- 2014: Conducted a freight analysis in Finnmark County, where also connections to Russia were looked into. Client: Finnmark County
- 2015: Carried out a market evaluation concerning exports of Norwegian Seafood, where transport opportunities through Russia and impact of sanctions where analyzed. Client: Seafood companies.
- As per October 2016, we are involved in several projects focusing on Russia, f.i. cruise traffic, port cooperation and market introduction for Norwegian companies and the Arctic Maritime Cluster. The projects are partly funded by the Kolarctic program and Innovation Norway

New markets - new perspectives

For several centuries, the traditional Russian-Norwegian Pomor trade created strong relations between Northern Norway and Archangel. In October 2016 a group of Norwegian maritime companies will visit Archangel for business meetings. The trip is a part of a project, where Norwegian companies' conducts targeted market approaches towards the Russian market. The project is managed by Transportutvikling AS and Innovation Norway in Russia, - and financially supported by Innovation Norway.

The project, where phase 1 commenced last year, had its initial focus on the Murmansk region. The market approach has been expanded and the project participants are now focusing eastwards and towards Archangel. The Archangel region is an old Russian maritime area with long traditions related to fisheries and international trade. The region has several sea- and river ports, well developed shipbuilding industry, a forestry- and mining sector and a huge potential when it comes to tourism.

Four Norwegian companies are participating on the business trip to Archangel. They will meet Regional Authorities and local companies/organizations. During the various meetings, the companies will establish new business contacts, present their products and services and discuss possibilities for future cooperation.

"*We have some good offers for our potential Russian partners*", says Erlend Kristiansen, head of the shipping company Barents AS.

"Besides transport of live fish and ferry operations, we will also offer our technology for disposal and utilization of biological waste from fish-processing plants and aquaculture farms."





"Our company has its own engineering office in Archangel, -but not so many projects for Russian clients", says Thomas Myhre, sales manager of NSK Ship Design". "Our expectations have improved during the last years and after Russia launched the State program for modernization of the fishery fleet, the market perspectives look better for ship designers. It creates new opportunities for developing our business in Russia."

Barents AS has developed solutions for receiving-, logistics- and processing of dead fish and fish waste.

"We started to work with Russian ship owners in 2014, when the first promotional project managed by Transportutvikling AS started. Since then, during a couple of years we have signed several contracts with Russian fishing companies.
